Because these infections can be passed on to other people, t is helpful to keep your own towel and dothes, which are not shared by others. To protect yourself from re-infection, these should be washed frequently.

WHAT IF YOU FORGET TO USE THE SPRAY? If you forget an application, apply! it as soon as possible! and then carry on as normal. If you only remember at the lime of the next application, just apply that application and then carry on as normal.
